# **Rules and Regulations:**

## Art. 1 - Competition Organizer

The XI INTERNATIONAL HARP COMPETITION "MARCEL TOURNIER" is organized by the Conservatory of Music "Stanislao Giacomantonio", Cosenza.

The competition is open to harpists of all nationalities, and aims to encourage and support new, talented harpists.

## Art. 2 - Categories

The contest is organized in six categories:

Category A: Pedal harp soloists - no age limit;

Category B: Pedal harp soloists - age limit 21;

Category C: Pedal harp soloists - age limit 16;

Category D: Chamber music with harp included - no age limit; Category E: Ensembles - harp duo/trio/quartet - no age limit.

Category F: Lever Harp Solists - no age limit.

Cat. F Free-choice program lasting 10 minutes. For all categories original compositions, transcriptions and arrangements of any period and style will be accepted. Performance by heart is not compulsory. The competitors are allowed to use their own instrument.

# Art. 6 - Sequence of events

The competition will take place from 8 - 9 October 2019 on the premises of the Conservatory of Music "Stanislao Giacomantonio" Casa della Musica Piazza Amendola - Cosenza, Italy. On 8 October at 10 a.m. at the same venue, the jury and the competitors will meet. The date and time of the competitors' preliminary rounds will be chosen by lot and they must bring a valid identity document with them. All rounds are open to the public, and the firm Salvi Harps will make instruments available. Participants must present the jury with 4 copies of the music they will perform.
